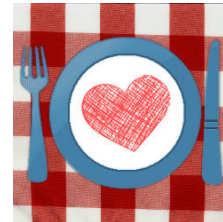

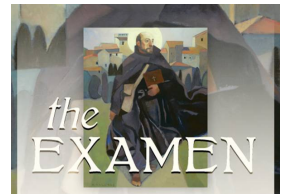
“God Calling” Testimonies of God’s Love
