## New worship series begins next Sunday, April 23

What is faith? Very simply, it is **belief in action**—acting on what we believe about God and God’s will and way for us. This acting on what we believe always involves a certain amount of “not seeing.” “Faith ... is the conviction of things not seen,” one New Testament writer tells us (Hebrews 11:1). Jesus himself said, “Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe” (John 20:29). Indeed, “we walk by faith, not by sight” writes the Apostle Paul.

During Jesus’ time on earth, his followers had the privilege of seeing him face to face, hearing his voice, being in his actual presence. After the resurrection of Jesus, the followers of Christ had to learn what it truly meant to “*walk by faith, not be sight.*” Though he rose from the grave, Jesus was only on earth physically for 40 more days, and even during that time, he was not always with them. Then “as they were watching, he was lifted up and a cloud took him out of their sight” (Acts 1:9).

NorthChurch is also in a season when we also need to walk by faith in a new way. Not just as a biblical teaching, but as an actual practice, taking small steps of faith, so that we might trust and follow Christ into the future God has for us ... even if we can’t see that future or the way ahead very right now.
